This 8 credit hour virtual online course teaches "first principles" of Photobiomodulation (PBM) commonly referred to in the past as Low Level Laser (Light) Therapy (LLLT) which has also been referred to as Phototherapy or Photomedicine. With today's opioid crisis, managing pain and enhancing the healing process without the uses of drugs or narcotics has never been more important. Topics discussions and demonstrations activities include the science, research, and clinical applications of PBM in today dental and systemic healthcare. The primary focus is on how light absorption effects tissue and the cascading of intracellular and extra cellular effects leading to physiological changes and enhanced clinical outcomes.

Discussions will focus on the science and clinical evidence on the role of PBM for the management of inflammation, edema, dental specific pain, joint pain, wound healing, and tissue regeneration. The goal is to obtain a knowledge matrix that is a simple model for understanding PBM's mechanism of action, clinical effects and treatment methods.

The course content is designed for all dental and medical professionals.

- Understanding the value that a properly implemented PBM patient care program brings to everyday oral health care.
- How to develop the appropriate workflow to efficiently provide PBM care routinely to patient care.
- How to present PBM's benefits and procedures to patients and properly and efficiently document the PBM treatments and discussions in the patient's clinical record.
